## 2020 ASSOCIATION YEAR IN REVIEW ... observations from your DOM

The end to the most unusual year of ministry is in the books. More than 100 Northwest Churches, our Baptist Collegiate Ministry leaders, and the Bethany Camp & Conference Center workers have adjusted, adapted and developed new ways to minister over this past year. In order to stay connected, there was no other choice. For part of last Spring our church doors were closed, and churches began using technology in a greater way to reach people. For other churches, it was the perfect time to upgrade the technology they were currently using. Thousands of church members stayed connected and worshiped in a new way. Many unreached people found churches online. Unfortunately, the Association has seen a 7% drop in revenue from our churches in 2020. The Administrative Council and Finance Team have every intention to continue funding the numerous ministries, mission churches, and ministry projects we support on your behalf.

The Association's financial support of Bethany Camp & Conference Center continues as the Camp was unable to sustain their ministry overhead since last March. However, the Camp's schedule is looking great for 2021. With the return of daytime activities and other events, Bethany has been able to assume much of their monthly expenses. The Association has supported your Camp in 2020 with over \$300,000 of assistance to maintain facilities and staff. Your support for September's "I Love Bethany" month, blessed the Camp with over \$40,000.

Thank you, churches of Northwest Association, for your financial support. We couldn't accomplish our supportive goals in assisting the local church without you. As 2021 begins, I encourage our churches to be as gracious in your Association giving as possible. My continued commitment to you is wise stewardship of those resources that you entrust to us.


