# 250 YEARS OF AMAZING GRACE

This year marks the 250th anniversary of the classic hymn, "Amazing Grace." In early 1773, John Newton in Olney, England, led his congregation to sing a new hymn he had just written for a special occasion. It spoke of his conversion, of his self-proclaimed wretchedness, and the

saving power of God's grace. Its popularity has never wavered across cultures and generations.

John Newton, a former slave-trader, was now a converted follower of Christ. After his conversion, Newton became a minister. A young articulate politician named William Wiberforce, who had also recently converted to faith in Christ, came calling one day. He won his first seat in Parliament at the age of 21. Newton counseled and mentored Wiberforce for years. That launched the young Parliament member to work tirelessly to end the slave trade in the British Empire. Newton encouraged Wiberforce to remain in Parliament, believing his integrity, reputation and influence could serve the cause of Christ better there, rather than a life in vocational ministry. In 1787, Wilberforce wrote in his dairy, "Almighty God has set before me two great objectives, the abolition of the slave trade and the reformation of morals." Wilberforce's emancipation battle would last decades. Due to failing health, he resigned his Parliament seat in 1825. When Wilberforce was on his death bed in 1833, he received word that Parliament had voted to free all 800,000 slaves throughout the British Empire.

William Wiberforce is a great example of what Jesus can do to those fully committed to Him in whatever position God places them, when God's "amazing grace" grips a life committed to Him.

What would ministers in 2023 counsel a young William Wilberforce to do? Perhaps, "Keep quiet. Keep your opinions to yourself. Don't challenge the status quo. Politics and faith don't mix?" President Calvin Coolidge said in the 1920's, "If good men don't hold office, bad men will."

Stay faithful in the fight for truth and righteousness.

Benton, has found a creative way to express the love of Christ towards their neighbors by building wheel-chair ramps for homeowners to give them greater freedom and less stress without having to climb stairs.

In 2013, a layman named Gene Wilson, who's with the Lord now, was inspired to see this come to fruition and began to put together a team of men with the knowledge and carpentry

skills to begin this new ministry. Over the last decade, fourteen men from First Baptist Church have served the Benton community by building ramps for homeowners with disabled children and other family members. The oldest homeowner was 104. Completed ramps: Over 150 and still going.

Each ramp costs approximately \$1,000 for materials. God has always provided the funds whenever a new ramp was needed.

These servants from Benton know they are the ones who are blessed by exercising their gifts for the Lord.

The harvest is great, but laborers like these men are making a difference for the Kingdom, one ramp at a time!




# GOD'S STILL WORKING ON ME!

#### U.S. Credit Card Debt Jumps 18.5%



American's credit card debt reached a record \$930 billion dollars in 2022, a jump of 18.5% in one year. Inflation is driving people to put everyday expenses on their credits cards. Americans carry an average of \$5,805 on their credit cards, most of which charge interest of

nearly 20%. Americans opened up 202 million new credit accounts in the fourth quarter of 2022, bringing the total number of credit cards held by all Americans living in the U.S. to 518.4 million.

# THE BAPTIST FAITH & MESSAGE

What We Believe as Southern Baptists

As we continue our study of the Baptist Faith & Message, we come to:

#### **Article II: God**

"There is one and only one living and true God. He is an intelligent, spiritual, and personal Being, the Creator, Redeemer, Preserver, and Ruler of the universe. God is infinite in His holiness and all other perfections. God is all powerful and all knowing; and His perfect knowledge extends to all things, past, present, and future, including the future decisions of His free creatures. To Him we owe the highest love, reverence, and obedience. The eternal triune God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being."

The Bible consistently declares there is one true and living God, the self-revealed Creator who alone must be loved and worshiped. All other gods are false.

Perhaps nowhere is the exclusivity of God stated more clearly than in the *Shema*, an affirmation of Judaism and a declaration of faith in one God. It is the oldest fixed daily prayer in Judaism, recited morning and evening since ancient times. It consists of three biblical passages, two of which instruct the Israelites to speak these things "when you lie down and when you rise up."

The best known part of the *Shema* is from the biblical passage: "Hear O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one! And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might."

Deut. 6:4-5. The Prophet Isaiah echoes this in 45:5, "I am the Lord, and there is no other; besides Me there is no God."

While the theme of one God runs consistently through Scripture, both the Old and New Testaments offer us increasing light into the existence of this One Being in three persons. Mark 12:29-30 and I Timothy 2:5-6.

How do we biblically define a term that never appears in the Bible? Jehovah's Witnesses, Muslim, and others are quick to point out the word Trinity is conspicuously absent from the pages of scripture. That doesn't mean the doctrine is missing in action. When we talk about the Trinity, it's important to show how Scripture describes God as one eternal being in three persons. This is not as easy it sounds, for the Trinity in some respects is a mystery, a revelation of God hidden in times past but revealed progressively from Genesis to Revelation.
