The most recent church calendar year has ended and the numbers are in. If your church doesn't report an Annual Church Profile, your church isn't included in these totals. Northwest Association has 110 churches and mission churches. You might say these totals are a view at the 30,000 foot level of Southern Baptist life in Caddo and Bossier parishes.

### **Total Church Membership - 61,285** Total Baptisms - 1,004 Other Additions to the church - 1,262

- On any given Sunday in your Association there are 14,000 Southern Baptists in worship and 10,018 in Small Group Bible
- Northwest Southern Baptists gave over 67 million dollars to their respective churches in the 2022-2023 church year.
- No Association in Louisiana gives more to the Cooperative Program than Northwest. In the 2022-2023 church year you gave over 2.5 million dollars, and nearly 5 million in total mission gifts.

Your Southern Baptist influence is strong in Northwest Louisiana. Never take that for granted. Where there is great influence there is also great responsibility. These are challenging days for many of our churches. A decade ago these numbers were much larger. Let's continue to push back the darkness with a gospel witness to Northwest Louisiana.




# For the 53<sup>rd</sup>
