General Information

- 1. Statement of Purpose The purpose of the Scholarship Committee is to provide financial assistance in form of a scholarship to students who are members of a cooperating Southern Baptist Church within the Northwest Louisiana Baptist Association, as the committee determines the need for financial aid.
- 2. Scholarship funds will be available to selected students planning to attend Louisiana College.
- 3. Several factors will be considered by the committee.
 - the number of children in the family.
 - other financial aid the applicant has received.
 - what attempts have been made to secure financial assistance.
 - the character and convictions of the applicant.
 - must maintain a "C" average while on the scholarship. Failure to do so will result in loss of the scholarship.
 - student deemed a full-time student by the college.
- 4. At the conclusion of each semester's work, scholarship recipient will submit grades to the attention of the Louisiana College Scholarship Committee, Northwest Louisiana Baptist Association, 5875 W. 70th St, Shreveport, Louisiana 71129. (Re-application will not be possible without the grades from the previous semester.)
- 5. Scholarship administration will follow the standard school year fall and spring. (\$300.00 per semester). Summer scholarships will not be offered.
- The scholarship monies will be paid directly to Louisiana College Financial Aid Office for the benefit of the recipient.
- 7. Details and procedures for scholarship application will be printed in the Northwest News and made available for the February Executive Board Meeting of each year.
- 8. At the end of each semester, scholarship recipients must submit to the committee: 1) a transcript of grades 2) any changes in financial status.
- 9. Scholarships will be given annually. Applications must be updated annually.
- 10. The guidelines will be issued with application form to all applicants.

Application Procedure

- 1. Request application form from the Northwest Louisiana Baptist Association Offices, 5875 W. 70th St, Shreveport, Louisiana 71129.
- 2. Complete and return scholarship application, with photograph of yourself, and letters of reference to the association office by May 1st of each year.
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded after May of each year.
- 4. You may be called for a personal interview.
